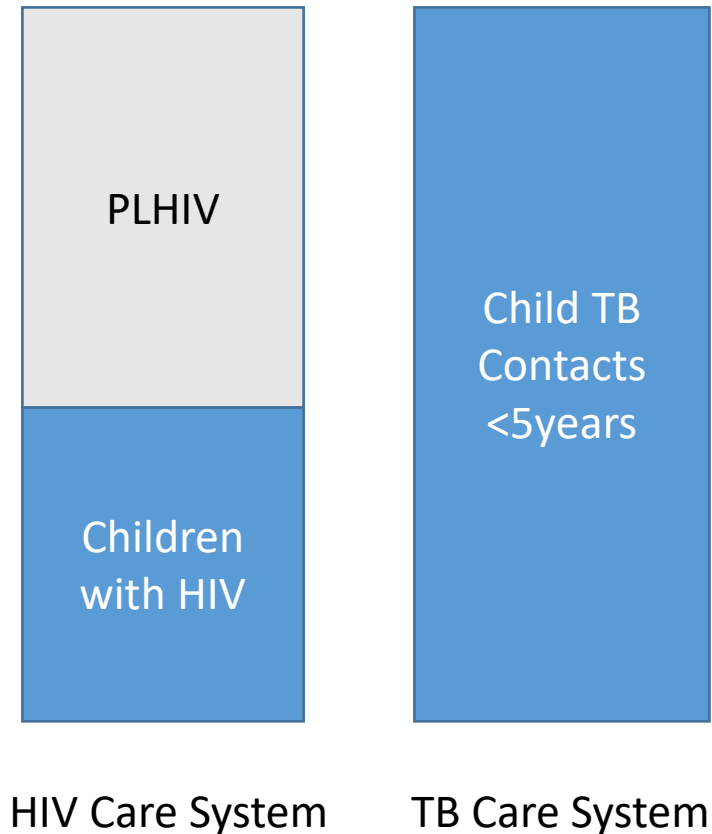


TB Preventive Therapy – Challenges and Solutions



- Procurement
 - Lower dose formulations (e.g. 100mg, 50mg INH)
 - Coordination (e.g. single or multiple purchase systems/funds?)
- Distribution (e.g. within HIV care system and within TB care system)
 - Children with HIV and child TB contacts
- Monitoring and evaluation (knowing performance relative to need)
 - Children with HIV (all children living with HIV)
 - Child TB contacts (all child TB contacts <5 not treated for TB)
- Screening
 - Clinician comfort/acceptability with clinical decision-making
 - Community-based versus facility-based
- Lack of understanding of rationale/acceptability (families, clinicians)
 - Demand generation
- Adherence
